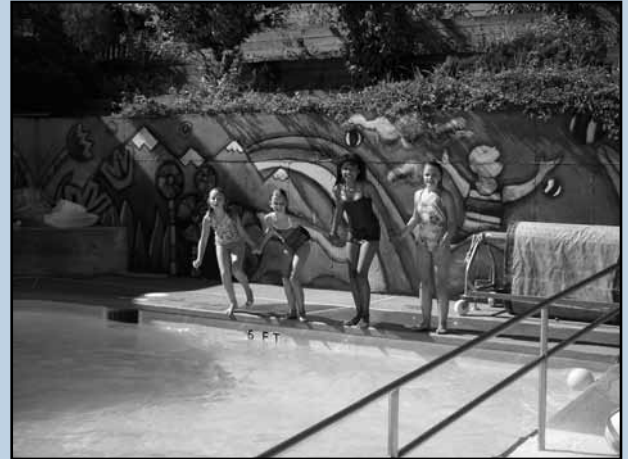

Dear Friends of Camp Māk-A-Dream,

I wanted to write to tell you how very much I appreciate the opportunity that you gave my children by providing them the chance to visit Camp Māk-A-Dream in Montana.

For the past two years, I have been in treatment for breast cancer- something that you don't expect or foresee as a 39 year old woman. As a result, I have only been able to work part-time and have not been able to provide my children with many extras including summer camps or vacations.

Because of the assistance of your organization, not only have my children been able to go to summer camp and take a vacation but you have provided them with memories that they will take with them throughout their entire lifetime. You provided them with a respite from the daily reminders of doctors, appointments, surgeries, treatments and all the other realities that come along when a member of the family has cancer. Often times, you find that there is support for the cancer patient but it is rare that there is a program focused totally on those close to the patient for whom the diagnosis can be just as devastating.

For both of my boys, this was not only the first time that they were on an airplane, but it was the first time they have been able to attend a week-long summer camp and the first time they were able to visit Montana. Thanks to your organization, my children found a little bit of fun and happiness during a very difficult time for our family. Thank you again. I hope you have the opportunity to provide these memories for other children for many years to come.
